His natural curiosity coupled with intensely critical thinking has resulted in architecture of innovation and a quest for excellence that is at the forefront of what is being produced this era.

Innovative, Award-Winning Architect

- Recipient of awards (eg: raic Governor General awards, Lieutenant-Governor of BC awards, Marche International des Professionels de l'Immobilier, Cip Award for Planning Excellence, National Excellence of the Waterfront) for projects of greatly varying size and complexity: residential projects, performance arts centres, mixed-use complexes, commercial centres, waterfront developments, neighbourhood plans, and city master plans.
- Champion of technical innovation and recipient of numerous innovation awards (eg: for new heavy timber wall systems at Surrey Central City, for structure at Vancouver Aquarium).
- Architect of highly popular exposition buildings such as Expo '86 (NWT Pavilion) and Expo '92 (Canada Pavilion - the only international pavilion retained by Spain as a legacy building).
- Designer of the recently opened Arena Stage in Washington DC, already declared one of the top ten contemporary buildings in Washington by the Urban Development Institute.
